2018 Undergraduate Admission - TCAS Round 1/1

International College, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang

The International College, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, has called for applications for undergraduate admission in Round 1/1 of the Thai University Central Admission System (TCAS) 2018. This round of admission is open to Thai nationals who satisfy the requirements set out below. Candidate selection in this round is based on academic excellence, as determined from academic records, standardized test scores, academic portfolios, and an interview. If qualified, applicants may also apply for the **International College Undergraduate Scholarship**. Eligibility requirements for the scholarship can be found in Section 3.

1. Programs and expected number of acceptances

Program	Number of acceptances in this round*
Bachelor of Engineering in Software Engineering (International Program)	40
Bachelor of Science in Engineering and Technology Management (International Program)	40

* The International College may accept a lower or greater number depending on the number of qualified applicants.

2. Applicant qualifications

The applicant is required to meet the requirements specified in section 2.1, 2.2, and 2.3 below.

2.1 Educational background

The applicant must satisfy one of the following requirements:

- Graduated or studying in Mathayom 6.
- Graduated or studying in the final year of 12-Year or 13-Year education in a school in Thailand or abroad.
- Graduated or studying in the final year of a vocational program in a college in Thailand or abroad and obtained (or expected to obtain prior to the start of Academic Year 2018) a qualification equivalent to Mathayom 6 or higher.
- Obtained (or expected to obtain prior to the start of Academic Year 2018) a qualification equivalent to Mathayom 6 as approved by the Ministry of Education of Thailand.

2.2 Academic records

The applicant should possess an excellent academic record which, at the minimum, meets the requirements specified in **2.2.1 or 2.2.2**:

- 2.2.1 The applicant's combined grade point average for all courses in **mathematics** as recorded in the applicant's latest academic transcript is no less than 3.0 in 4.0 scale (or equivalent).
- 2.2.2 The applicant has taken at least one of the following standardized tests and obtained a score which meets the minimum requirement specified:

SAT (Math section) or SAT Subject test (Math Level I or Math Level II)	600
ACT (Math section)	24
AP test for a subject in mathematics	4
GCE A-Level or GCE AS-Level for a subject in mathematics	B
GCE O-Level or GCSE or IGCSE for a subject in mathematics	A
IB Diploma score for a subject in mathematics	5
NCEA (Level 2 or Level 3) for a subject in mathematics	M
China National Higher Education Entrance Examination (Gaokao) score of the mathematics subject	90
CU-AAT (Math section)	480

* Only a score report which is valid (i.e. not expired) on the day of the interview will be taken into consideration.

2.3 English language requirements

The applicant should possess good skills of English which, at the minimum, meets the requirements specified in **2.3.1 or 2.3.2**:

- 2.3.1 The applicant has obtained one of the following test scores and meets the minimum requirement specified:

Test	Minimum Score
TOEFL (iBT)	61
TOEFL (ITP or paper-based test)	500
IELTS	5.5
Cambridge English Exam (FCE/CAE/CPE)	160
China National Higher Education Entrance Examination (Gaokao) score of the English subject	90
CU-TEP	65

- 2.3.2 The applicant has been studying for two years or longer in a school or a college outside Thailand in which the primary language of instruction is English.

3. International College Undergraduate Scholarship

The International College offers a limited number of scholarship awards to new undergraduate students with excellent academic records. The number of awards, the eligibility conditions, and the terms and conditions of the scholarship are as summarized in the table below. International College Undergraduate Scholarship for Students with Excellent Academic Records	
Number of awards	– Up to 8 awards are expected to be given in this round
Eligibility	– Completed or expected to complete high-school/secondary-school education with a grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.25 out of 4.0 (or equivalent) – Beginning the study at the International College in the upcoming academic year
Benefits	– Full tuition fee exemption during the normal study period at the International College, KMITL (excluding any fee payable to other academic institutions)
Conditions	– The awardee must maintain the grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.75 in every semester during their study period at KMITL. – In every semester, the awardee is required to do volunteer works which benefit the university or the International College for at least 40 hours/semester.
Candidate selection	– All eligible applicants of this scholarship are required to take a (paper-based) qualifying examination. – Selection of scholarship awardees in this round is based on the score of the qualifying examination.

4. Tuition fee

The tuition fee for the students entering the program in Academic Year 2018 is 75,000 THB per semester. This fee does not cover the cost of optional overseas training and the cost of textbooks.

5. Application procedure and schedule



1) Application and portfolio submission – See the instructions for (on-line) application and portfolio submission at http://www.ic.kmitl.ac.th/apply . – Each applicant can apply for one or more programs.	Until 27 Nov 2017, 16.00 (Thailand time)
2) Application fee payment – The application fee is 300 Baht for each program applied. The application fee is non-refundable. – Application fee can be paid by bank transfer. Follow the instructions given after the online application has been submitted. Payment must be received by the date and time shown in the right.	Until 28 Nov 2017, 16.00 (Thailand time)
3) Interview – Each applicant who satisfies all the requirements (Section 2) will be informed via an email to come to the International College for an interview.	2 Dec 2017

- Applicants who reside outside Thailand at the time of the interview may request for an interview via video conference.	
4) Scholarship exam (for scholarship applicants only) All eligible applicants of the International College undergraduate scholarship are required to take the qualifying examination at the International College.	2 Dec 2017
5) Announcement of the results The list of the accepted applicants and the scholarship awardees will be announced on the website www.ic.kmitl.ac.th . The decision made by the admission committee is final.	6 Dec 2017
6) Confirmation through TCAS Clearing-house (Round 1/1)	15 – 19 Dec 2017
7) Payment of tuition fee Every accepted applicant is required to pay the tuition fee for Semester 1/2018 in full by bank transfer during this period	4 – 10 Jan 2018
8) Start of Semester 1/2018	Early August 2018
