International Academy of Aviation Industry, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, invites qualified applicants to apply for admission to the Bachelor of Engineering Program in Aeronautical Engineering and Commercial Pilot for the Academic Year 2018. This round of admissions is open to all students who have excellent academic records and satisfy the requirements set out below. Selection is based on the applicant's academic records, standardized test scores, an interview and a civil aviation medical examination.

1. Program

B.Eng (Aeronautical Engineering and Commercial Pilot) - 4 year degree

Enrollment target: 50 students

2. Applicant Requirements

2.1 The applicant must have graduated from or currently be in a Matthayom 6 Science and Mathematics program or equivalent level from an international school or high school abroad that has been approved by the Ministry of Education of Thailand.

2.2 Outstanding students who would like to apply for the quota system, must satisfy at least 3 out of 4 criteria as specified in 2.2.1-2.2.4:

2.2.1 The grade point average for 4 semesters is not less than 3.5 (4.0 scale).

2.2.2 Applicants must achieve the minimum score on one of the following Mathematics tests:

2.2.3 Applicants must achieve the minimum score on one of the following Physics tests:

- PAT III (73 : Physics)	150
- SAT II (Physics)	600
- AP test : Physics I (B) or Physics II (C) or Mechanics	3
- A-Level (Physics)	C
- AS-Level (Physic)	B
- IGCSE (Physic)	B
- IB-Diploma (Physic)	5
- CU-ATS	800

2.2.4 Applicants must achieve the minimum score on one of the following English tests:

- CU-TEP	65
- TU-GET	500
- GAT (Part 2 – English)	100
- TOEFL (PBT : Paper-based test)	550
- TOEFL (IBT : Internet-based test)	65
- TOEFL (CBT : Computer-based test)	213

- Cambridge English Exams – FCE or CAE or CPE	160
- Gaokao score of English subject	90

All submitted scores should be valid (i.e., not expired) on the day of the interview.

2.3 The other applicants should submit existing scores and a statement of purpose (not less than 200 words) on A4 paper.

4. How to apply

Apply online through the school website at www.reg.kmitl.ac.th. The non-refundable application fee of 300 baht and the service charge of 10 THB may be paid at any branch of Kasikorn Bank or Siam Commercial Bank.

5. Documents

Prepare the following documents to be submitted at the interview (Saturday, November 18, 2017).

- 5.1 Completed application form
- 5.2 Academic transcript: one certified copy
- 5.3 ID card or government issued card
- 5.4 Portfolio
- 5.5 Civil aviation medical examination certificate

6. Interviews

- 6.1 Interviews begin at 9.00 am on Saturday, November 18, 2017
- 6.2 The location of the interviews will be announced when the names of the candidates are announced.

Note: The number of students admitted may be greater or less than the number posted, depending on the number of qualified applicants.

7. Clearing House confirmation

Qualified applicants must confirm with the Clearing House from December 15 – 19, 2017 their intention to attend King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang.

8. Enrollment Confirmation

Accepted applicants for the program will be announced on December 27, 2017 at www.reg.kmitl.ac.th. Those accepted applicants must confirm their decision to enroll at KMITL by paying the confirmation fee from January 4-10, 2018. Failure to meet this payment deadline will result in official rejection from this program. This payment is non-refundable under any circumstances. This confirmation fee will count toward the tuition fee for the first semester.

9. Grounds for disqualification

9.1 Qualified but did not confirm with the Clearing House by the deadline.


9.2 Qualified but did not confirm online and make the confirmation payment by the deadline.

9.3 Those who have not graduated from an approved high school.

10. Tuition fee

The tuition fees are made in 2 separate payments. The first is the tuition fee for the Aeronautical Engineering program which is 90,000 baht per semester. (Paid to KMITL as detailed at www.reg.kmitl.ac.th) The second is the fee for the Commercial Pilot course which is 350,000 baht per semester. (Paid to Asia Aviation Academy).
