Bachelor of Engineering in Aeronautical Engineering and Commercial Pilot, Academic Year 2018 International Academy of Aviation Industry

International Academy of Aviation Industry, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, invites qualified applicants to apply for admission to the Bachelor of Engineering Program in Aeronautical Engineering and Commercial Pilot in Academic Year 2018 by Portfolio Round 1/2 (starting in August 2018). This round of admission is open to all students who have excellent academic records and satisfy the requirements set out in Section 1 and Section 2 as below. Selection is based on the applicant's academic records, standardized test scores, an interview and Civil Aviation Medical Examination.

1. Program

B.Eng (Aeronautical Engineering and Commercial Pilot) - 4 year degree

Enrollment target : 50 students

2. Applicant qualifications

The applicant is required to meet the requirements specified in section 2.1 and 2.2 below

2.1 Educational background

The applicant must satisfy one of the following requirements:

- a) Graduated or studying in Matthayom 6, in Science – Mathematics Program.
- b) Graduated or studying in the final year of Grade - 12 or Year - 13 education in an international school in Thailand or in a high school/secondary school abroad or equivalent to Matthayom 6 as being approved by the Ministry of Education of Thailand

2.2 Academic records

There are 2 types of applicant which are quota and general. The quota applicant should possess an excellent academic record and satisfies at least 3 out of 4 minimum requirement as specified in 2.2.1 , 2.2.2 , 2.2.3 and 2.2.4:

2.2.1 The applicant's combined grade point average for at least 4 semesters as recorded in the applicant's academic transcript is no less than 3.5 in 4.0 scale (or equivalent).

2.2.2 The applicant has taken at one of the following standardized Mathematics tests and obtained a score which meet the minimum requirement specified:

2.2.3 The applicant has taken at least one of the following standardized physics tests and obtained a score which meet the minimum requirement specified:

2.2.4 The applicant has taken at least one of the following standardized Physics tests and obtained a score which meet the minimum requirement specified:

2.3 The general applicant shall submit existing score and statement of purpose with A4 size minimum 200 words

4. How to apply

Apply online through www.reg.kmitl.ac.th and pay the fee through the counter of Kasikorn Bank or Siam Commercial Bank all branches nationwide. Application fee is 300 baht with a bank fee of 10 baht.

5. Proof of application prepare the following documents to be submitted on the interview (Saturday, 3 February 61).

5.1 Print the application and download it through www.reg.kmitl.ac.th and list the names.

5.2 Copy of academic transcript, one copy, certified true copy.

5.3 ID card or government issued ticket

5.4 Portfolio

5.5 Certificate of Medical Examination

6. Method of selection interviews in all disciplines.

6.1 Interview at 09.00 onwards

6.2 The place where the interview will be announced when the names of the candidates are announced.

Note: The number of students admitted may be greater or less than the number posted, depending on the number of qualified applicants.

7. Qualified applicants must confirm the Clearing House through the Association of Thailand's Chulalongkorn University to indicate their intention to study as a student of King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang within 19 - 22 March 2018. Do not act on the date of the deadline.

8. Reporting to eligible applicants and payment to confirm the right to enter the institution.

Qualified candidates at Clearing House and have been declared eligible for entry into the King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang must report to eligible applicants at www.reg.kmitl.ac.th and paying the confirmation fee according to the announcement of the Institute of Payments confirming the right to study in King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, dated 2 March 2012 to confirm the admission. If no action is taken, the scheduled time will be waived.

Eligible applicants who have confirmed their entry into the program by internet reporting and payment confirmation. However, waiver of non-attendance at the institution, the institution will not refund any case.

Qualified applicants who have confirmed and paid to confirm eligibility ,when studying in the Institute you will not be required to pay the fee for the first semester as a student. By the way, it is considered as a fee for a paid study in that semester.

9. Disqualification

9.1 Qualified but not confirmed Clearing House at the time of the deadline.

9.2 Qualified but not reported candidates are eligible to study on the Internet and make the confirmation payment by the deadline.

9.3 Those who have been selected but not completed in the academic year. To be disclaimed

10. Tuition fee

The tuition fees are made in 2 separate payments. The first is the tuition fee for the Aeronautical Engineering Program which is 90,000 baht per semester. (Paid to KMITL as detailed at www.reg.kmitl.ac.th) The second is the fee for the Commercial Pilot course which is 350,000 baht per semester. (Paid to Asia Aviation Academy).
