Undergraduate Admission - TCAS Round Portfolio 1/2 for Oversea Students

King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang

Academic Year 2018

Faculty of Information Technology, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang call for applications for undergraduate admission in round Portfolio 1/2 of Thai University Central Admission System (2018). Overseas students should satisfy the requirements set out below. Candidate selection in this round is based on academic excellence, as determined from academic records, standardized test scores, academic portfolios, and an interview.

1. Program and number of openings in this round

B.Sc. Business Information Technology (International Program) 10 persons

Faculty of Information Technology may accept a lower or greater number of applications depending on the number of qualified applicants.

2. Applicant qualifications

2.1 The applicant must have graduated from or currently be in Matthayom 6 or equivalent level from an international school or high school abroad that has been approved by the Ministry of Education of Thailand.

2.2 Applicants must have scored on one of the following mathematical tests.

2.2.1 Following as :

Mathematical Tests
1. SAT I
2. SAT (Math section) or SAT Subject test (Math I or Math II)
3. ACT (Math section)
4. AP test for a mathematical subject
5. A-Level or AS-Level for a mathematical subject
6. O-Level or GCSE or IGCSE for a mathematical subject
7. IB-Diploma for a mathematical subject
8. NCEA (level 2 or Level 3) for a mathematical subject
9. Gaokao score of Mathematics

10. Other Math Score

Or

2.2.2 Have a GPA of all mathematical subjects at the high school level of more than 70% or 3.0 (for the A – F grading system).

2.3 Applicants must have scored on one of the following English tests .

2.3.1 Following as:

English Tests
1. TOEFL (iBT – Internet-based test)
2. TOEFL (ITP or paper-based test)
3. IELTS
4. Cambridge English Exams – FCE or CAE or CPE
5. Gaokao score of English Language
6. CU-TEP
7. TU-GET
8. Other English Scores

Or

2.3.2 The applicant has been studying for two years or longer in a school or a college outside Thailand in which the primary language of instruction is English.

2.4 The exam scores in 2.2.1 and 2.3.1 are not more than 2 years old.

- 3.1 A photocopy of official academic transcripts or equivalent level diploma as approved by the Ministry of Education of Thailand
- 3.2 A photocopy of the applicant's national identification card or passport
- 3.3 A photo of the applicant
- 3.4 A photocopy of household registration (if any)
- 3.5 Recommendation letters from the applicant's teachers or supervisors
- 3.6 Resume (if any)
- 3.7 Curriculum vitae or portfolio

5. Application submission

The applicant must upload all necessary documents via our online application system at <http://bit.kmitl.ac.th>.

6. Selection

6.1 Interview candidates who live outside Thailand may request an interview via video conference over the Internet.

6.2 The applicant must have at least one of the test scores in section 2.2 and 2.3 above.

7. Announcement of the qualified and accepted applicants

The list of qualified shortlisted and accepted applicants will be announced at <http://bit.it.kmitl.ac.th>

8. Enrollment verification and confirmation fee

Qualified candidates who have been declared eligible for entry into King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang must verify their enrollment at www.reg.kmitl.ac.th and pay the confirmation fee. If no action is taken by the deadline, the applicants' candidacy will be cancelled.

Qualified applicants who have confirmed and paid the confirmation fee will not be required to pay the first semester's tuition fee. The confirmation fee is considered as the first semester's tuition fee. The confirmation fee is non-refundable.

9. Disqualification

10.1 Qualified applicants who do not verify their enrollment on <http://reg.kmitl.ac.th> by the deadline will be disqualified.

10.2 Candidates who do not make confirmation payment by the deadline will be disqualified.

10.3 Candidates who have been selected but not completed their high school degree before the commencement of the academic year will be disqualified.

10. Business Information Technology Undergraduate Scholarship

10.1 Fully funded scholarships for international students living outside of Thailand

10.1.1 Up to 2 awards per year

10.1.2 Full tuition fee exemption during the normal 4-year study period

10.1.3 Monthly allowance of 9,000 THB

10.2 Selection

Selection of the candidates is based on the applicant's academic records, mathematic and English proficiency scores, extra-curricular activities, and an interview.

10.3 Requirements

The applicant must fulfill the following requirements:

10.3.1 The applicants must have a current residential address in a country other than Thailand.

10.3.2 The applicants must meet one of the following mathematical proficiency criteria:

1. Have a GPA of all mathematical subjects at the high school level of more than 80% or 3.5 (for the A – F grading system) or

2. The applicant has obtained one of the following test scores and meets the minimum requirement specified:

SAT (Math section) or SAT Subject test (Math I or Math II)	600
ACT (Math section)	24
AP test for a mathematical subject	4
A-Level or AS-Level for a mathematical subject	B
O-Level or GCSE or IGCSE for a mathematical subject	A

NCEA (level 2 or Level 3) for a mathematical subject	(M) erit
Gaokao score of Mathematics	90 (out of 150)

10.3.3 Applicants must meet one of the following English proficiency criteria:

1. The applicant has obtained one of the following test scores and meets the minimum requirements specified:

Test	Required Score
TOEFL (iBT – Internet-based test)	61
TOEFL (ITP or paper-based test)	500
IELTS	5.5
Cambridge English Exams – FCE or CAE or CPE	160
Gaokao score of English Language	90 (out of 150)

Or

2. Had studied abroad in a school that teaches in English at the high school level or its equivalent levels for more than 2 consecutive years.

10.4 Supporting documents

Scholarship candidates must provide the following documents:

- 10.4.1 Complete the application form on <http://bit.it.kmitl.ac.th>
- 10.4.2 A photocopy of Official Academic Transcripts
- 10.4.3 Recommendation letters from teachers or supervisors
- 10.4.4 The applicant must have test scores satisfying section 10.3.2 and 10.3.3 above
- 10.4.5 A photocopy of the applicant's national identification card or passport
- 10.4.6 A color photo (25 mm x 30 mm)
- 10.4.7 Resume (if any)
- 10.4.8 Curriculum vitae or portfolio

10.5 Conditions

The awardee must comply with these conditions:

10.5.1 The awardee's first semester grade point score (GPS) must be at least 3.25 and the awardee must also have a grade point average (GPA) of 3.25. In addition, the awardee must not receive a GPS of less than 3.00 in any given semester.

10.5.2 The awardee must not fail (F) any subject.

10.5.3 The awardee has good behavior and never breaks the student discipline code.

10.5.4 The awardee is required to work as a teaching assistant or a research assistant at the Information Technology faculty.

Notification: *If the awardee does not comply with the above conditions, the faculty may suspend funding for the next semester or for the rest of the course.*

11. Tuition fee


