Undergraduate Admissions - TCAS Round 5 for Foreign Students Faculty of Information Technology King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang Academic Year 2020

Faculty of Information Technology, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang is open for undergraduate admission to TCAS Round 5 of The Thai University Central Admission System (2020). Foreign students should satisfy the requirements as set out below. Candidate selection will be based on academic excellence, as determined from academic records, standardized test scores, academic portfolios, and finally, an interview.

1. Program and number of openings this round:

B.Sc. Business Information Technology (International Program) 5 persons

The Faculty of Information Technology may accept a lower or greater number of applications depending on the number of qualified applicants.

2. Applicant qualifications

- 2.1 The applicant must have completed or currently be in Matthayom 6 or an equivalent level from an international school or high school abroad that has been approved by the Ministry of Education of Thailand.
 - 2.2 Applicants must have scores from one of the following mathematical tests.

- 2.2.2 Have a GPA of all mathematical subjects at the high school level of more than 70% or 3.0 (for the A F grading system).
 - 2.3 Applicants must have scored on one of the following English tests .

- 2.3.2 The applicant has been studying for two years or longer in a school or a college outside Thailand in which the primary language of instruction is English.
 - 2.4 The exam scores in 2.2.1 and 2.3.1 cannot be older than 2 years.

- 3.3 A photo for the application.
- 3.4 A photocopy of household registration (if any).
- 3.5 Recommendation letters from the applicant's teachers or supervisors.
- 3.6 A resume (if any).
- 3.7 A Curriculum vitae or Portfolio.

5. Application submission

The applicant must upload all necessary documents via our online application system at http://www.reg.kmitl.ac.th/TCAS/international.php

6. Selection

- 6.1 Candidates to be interviewed who live outside Thailand may request an interview via video conference over the Internet.
 - 6.2 The applicant must have <u>at least one</u> of the test scores in sections 2.2 and 2.3 above.

7. Announcement of the qualified and accepted applicants

8. Enrollment verification and confirmation fee

Qualified candidates who have been declared eligible for entry into King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang must verify their enrollment at http://www.reg.kmitl.ac.th/TCAS/international.php and pay the confirmation fee. If no action is taken by the deadline, the applicants' candidacy will be canceled.

Qualified applicants who have confirmed and paid the confirmation fee will not be required to pay the first semester's tuition fee. The confirmation fee is considered as the first semester's tuition fee. The confirmation fee is non-refundable.

9. Disqualification

- 9.1 Qualified applicants who do not verify their enrollment at http://www.reg.kmitl.ac.th/TCAS/international.php by the deadline will be disqualified.
- 9.2 Candidates who do not make the confirmation payment by the deadline will be disqualified.
- 9.3 Candidates who have been selected but have not completed their high school degree before the commencement of the academic year will be disqualified.

10. Business Information Technology Undergraduate Scholarship

- 10.1 Fully funded scholarships for international students living outside of Thailand
 - 10.1.1 Up to 2 awards per year
 - 10.1.2 Full tuition fee exemption during the normal 4-year study period (excluding any fee payable to other academic institutions).
 - 10.1.3 Monthly allowance of 9,000 THB

11. Tuition fee

The tuition fee for students entering the program in Academic Year 2020 is 70,000 THB per semester. After the payment has been made, the institution will neither refund nor reimburse the tuition fee, and the student shall not pursue legal action against the institution under any circumstances.
