

Announcement of Quota Admission (Round 3/2014) Bachelor of Engineering in Software Engineering, Academic Year 2014 International College, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang

The International College, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, would like to announce the quota admission (round 3/2014) for students with excellent academic records for entry to the **Bachelor of Engineering in Software Engineering** program in Academic Year 2014. The admission criteria and the application process are as follows:

1. Applicant qualifications

The applicant is required to meet the requirements specified in section 1.1, 1.2, and 1.3 below. The applicant is advised to consult the International College if not certain whether the applicant's qualification is eligible.

1.1 Educational background

The applicant must satisfy one of the following requirements:

- a) Graduated or studying in Matthayom 6.
- b) Graduated or studying in the final year of a 12-Year or 13-Year education in an international school in Thailand or in a high school/secondary school abroad.
- c) Graduated or studying in the final year in a school which has a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on academic cooperation with KMITL.
- d) Graduated or studying in the final year of a vocational program in a college in Thailand or abroad in which the main language of instruction is English and, when completed, obtained a qualification which is equivalent to Matthayom 6 or higher.
- e) Obtained (or expect to obtain before the start of Academic Year 2014) a qualification equivalent to Matthayom 6 as being approved by the Ministry of Education of Thailand.

1.2 Academic records

The applicant should possess an excellent academic record which, at the minimum, meets the requirements specified in 1.2.1 or 1.2.2:

- 1.2.1 The applicant's combined grade point average for all courses in mathematics as recorded in the applicant's latest academic transcript is no less than 3.0 in 4.0 scale (or equivalent).
- 1.2.2 The applicant has taken at least <u>one of the following standardized tests</u> and obtained a score which meets the minimum requirement specified:
 - SAT (Math section) or SAT Subject test (Math Level I or Math Level II) with a score of 600 or above

- ACT (Math section) with a score of 24 or above
- AP test in a subject in mathematics with a score of 4 or above
- GCE A-Level or GCE AS-Level in a subject in mathematics with grade B or above
- GCE O-Level or GCSE or IGCSE in a subject in mathematics with grade A or above
- IB-Diploma with a score of at least 5 in a subject in mathematics
- NCEA (Level 2 or Level 3) in a subject in mathematics with grade "Achieved (A)" or above
- CU-AAT (Math section) with a score of 480 or above

Only a score report which is valid (i.e. not expired) on the day of the interview will be taken into consideration.

1.3 English language requirements

The applicant should possess good skills of English which, at the minimum, meets the requirements specified in 1.3.1 or 1.3.2:

- 1.3.1 The applicant has been studying for two years or longer in a school or a college outside Thailand in which the main language of instruction is English.
- 1.3.2 The applicant has obtained <u>one of the following test scores</u> and meets the minimum requirement specified:
 - IELTS score of at least 5.5
 - TOEFL (iBT) score of at least 61
 - CU-TEP score of at least 65 (out of 120)
 - TU-GET score of at least 500
 - GAT (Part 2) score of least 100

Only a score report which is valid (i.e. not expired) on the day of the interview will be taken into consideration.

2. Number of acceptances

The International College expects to accept 10 students from this round of admission. The International College may accept a lower or greater number of students depending on the number of qualified applicants.

5) Start of Semester 1/2014 Semester 1 of Academic Year 2014 is expected to begin on 11 August 2014. Prior to the start of the semester, there will be a pre-sessional course and an orientation session in which all new students should attend. The actual dates will be announced later on the International College website.	11 August 2014

4. Application submission

The application can be made <u>free-of-charge</u>. Please follow the steps below to prepare and submit an application.

- 1) Complete and submit the on-line application form at: http://www.ic.kmitl.ac.th/apply
- 2) Prepare the supporting documents listed below. Please include your name and your Application ID number on each document submitted.
 - a) A photocopy of the applicant's national identification card or passport
 - b) A photocopy of the applicant's name-change certificate (if any)
 - c) A latest official academic transcript

if the applicant has already graduated, an official copy of the final transcript should be submitted. Otherwise, the applicant should submit the latest official transcript available at the time the application is made, and if there is any subsequent update, the applicant is required to bring the most up-to-date official transcript to the interview. The applicant may send a photocopy of his/her academic transcript instead of an original one, in which case the applicant is required to bring an original copy of his/her academic transcript to the interview.

d) Standardized-test score reports (if required)

A photocopy of the score report for each applicable standardized test should be sent. However, in case a score report is not available at the time the application is made, the applicant must indicate in his/her application form which test the applicant is waiting for the result, and then send a photocopy of the score report to the International College once the test result becomes available. In any case, the applicant is required to bring the original score report to the interview and present it to the examiners.

e) An academic portfolio (if any)

The applicant may send his/her academic portfolio and any additional supporting document. Alternatively, the applicant may bring those documents to the interview and present them to the examiners.
