

Announcement of Quota Admission Bachelor of Science in Engineering and Technology Management Academic Year 2016

International College, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang

The International College, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, invites qualified applicants to apply for admission to the **Bachelor of Science Program in Engineering and Technology Management (International Program)** in Academic Year 2016 (starting in August 2016). This round of admission is open to all students who have excellent academic records and satisfy the requirements set out in Section 1 below. Selection of the qualified candidates for this round of admission is based on the applicant' academic records, standardized test scores, and an interview. If qualified, applicants may also apply for the **International College Undergraduate Scholarships**. Requirements for scholarship applicants can be found in Section 2.

1. Applicant qualifications

The applicant is required to meet the requirements specified in section 1.1, 1.2, and 1.3 below.

1.1 Educational background

The applicant must satisfy one of the following requirements:

- a) Graduated or studying in Matthayom 6.
- b) Graduated or studying in the final year of a 12-Year or 13-Year education in an international school in Thailand or in a high school/secondary school abroad.
- c) Graduated or studying in the final year in a school which has a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on academic cooperation with KMITL.
- d) Graduated or studying in the final year of a vocational program in a college in Thailand or abroad where the primary language of instruction is English, and obtained (or expected to obtain prior to the start of Academic Year 2016) a qualification equivalent to Matthayom 6 or higher.
- e) Obtained (or expected to obtain prior to the start of Academic Year 2016) a qualification equivalent to Matthayom 6 as approved by the Ministry of Education of Thailand.

1.2 Academic records

The applicant should possess an excellent academic record which, at the minimum, meets the requirements specified in 1.2.1 or 1.2.2:

1.2.1 The applicant's combined grade point average for all courses in **mathematics** as recorded in the applicant's latest academic transcript is no less than 3.0 in 4.0 scale (or equivalent).

- 1.2.2 The applicant has taken at least <u>one of the following standardized tests</u> and obtained a score which meets the minimum requirement specified:
 - SAT (Math section) or SAT Subject test (Math Level I or Math Level II) with a score of 600 or above
 - ACT (Math section) with a score of 24 or above
 - AP test in a subject in mathematics with a score of 4 or above
 - GCE A-Level or GCE AS-Level in a subject in mathematics with grade B or above
 - GCE O-Level or GCSE or IGCSE in a subject in mathematics with grade A or above
 - IB-Diploma with a score of at least 5 in a subject in mathematics
 - NCEA (Level 2 or Level 3) in a subject in mathematics with grade "Merit (M)" or above
 - CU-AAT (Math section) with a score of 480 or above

Only a score report which is valid (i.e. not expired) on the day of the interview will be taken into consideration.

1.3 English language requirements

The applicant should possess good skills of English which, at the minimum, meets the requirements specified in 1.3.1 or 1.3.2 or 1.3.3:

- 1.3.1 The applicant's combined grade point average for all courses in English language study as recorded in the applicant's latest academic transcript is no less than 3.0 in 4.0 scale (or equivalent).
- 1.3.2 The applicant has obtained <u>one of the following test scores</u> and meets the minimum requirement specified:
 - IELTS score of at least 5.5
 - TOEFL (iBT) score of at least 61
 - CU-TEP score of at least 65 (out of 120)
 - TU-GET score of at least 500

Only a score report which is valid (i.e. not expired) on the day of the interview will be taken into consideration.

1.3.3 The applicant has been studying for two years or longer in a school or a college in which the primary language of instruction is English.

2. International College Undergraduate Scholarships

The International College is offering two types of scholarships for undergraduate students, each with a limited number of awards. The number of awards, the eligibility conditions, and the terms and conditions of each type of scholarships are as summarized in the following table. Note that application for scholarships is <u>optional</u>; please indicate on the (on-line) application for admission whether to apply for scholarships or not.

3. Number of acceptances

The International College expects to accept 50 applicants from this round of admission. The International College may accept a lower or greater number depending on the total number of qualified applicants.

4. Tuition fee

The tuition fee for the students entering the program in Academic Year 2016 is 75,000 THB per semester. This fee does <u>not</u> cover the cost of optional overseas training and the cost of textbooks.

 Each applicant who satisfies all the requirements (Section 1) will be informed via an email to come to the International College for an interview. All eligible applicants of the "Undergraduate Scholarship for Students with Excellent Academic Records" are required to take a qualifying examination on the day of the interview. Applicants who are residing outside Thailand at the time of the interview may request for an interview via video conference. 	9 Jan 2016
3) Announcement of the results The list of the accepted applicants and the scholarship awardees will be announced on the website www.ic.kmitl.ac.th/etm . The decision made by the admission committee is final.	20 Jan 2016
4) Payment of tuition fee Every accepted applicant is required to confirm their intent to enroll and pay the tuition fee for Semester 1/2016 in full by bank transfer during this period.	27 Jan – 2 Feb 2016
5) Start of Semester 1/2016 Semester 1 of Academic Year 2016 is expected to begin in early August 2016. Prior to the start of the semester, there will be a pre-sessional course and an orientation session in which all new students are recommended to attend. 6. Application submission

The application can be made <u>free-of-charge</u>. Please follow the steps below to prepare and submit an application.

- 1) Complete the on-line application form at: http://www.ic.kmitl.ac.th/apply
- 2) If you wish to apply for a scholarship, specify which type of scholarships to apply and complete the accompanying scholarship application form.
- 3) Prepare the supporting documents listed below. Please include your name and your Application ID number on each document submitted.
 - a) A photocopy of the applicant's national identification card or passport
 - b) A photocopy of the applicant's name-change certificate (if any)
 - c) A latest official academic transcript

If the applicant has already graduated, an official final transcript should be submitted. Otherwise, the applicant should submit the latest official transcript available at the time the application is made, and if there is any subsequent update, the applicant is required to bring the most up-to-date official transcript to the interview. The applicant may send

a photocopy of his/her academic transcript instead of an original one, in which case the applicant is required to bring an original transcript to the interview.

d) Standardized-test score reports (if required)

A photocopy of the score report for each applicable standardized test should be sent. However, in case a score report is not available at the time the application is made, the applicant must indicate in his/her application form which test the applicant is waiting for the result, and then send a photocopy of the score report to the International College once the test result becomes available. The applicant is required to bring the original score report to the interview and present it to the examiners.

e) An academic portfolio (if any)

An academic portfolio and any additional supporting document may be included with the application. Alternatively, the applicant may bring those documents to the interview and present them to the examiners.

- 3) Submit the supporting documents by one of the following methods:
 - a) Scan the documents and upload the files onto the online application system. This must be done after creating a new online application but before submitting the application.
