

Announcement of Direct Admission B.Eng. in Aeronautical Engineering and Commercial Pilot, Academic Year 2016 King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang

King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang invites qualified applicants to apply for admission to the Bachelor of Engineering Program in Aeronautical Engineering and Commercial Pilot (English Program), for International Academy of Aviation Industry (IAAI) in Academic Year 2016 (starting in August 2016). This round of direct admission is open to all students, both Thais and foreigners, who have excellent academic records and satisfy the requirements given below. Selection of the qualified candidates for this round of direct admission is based on the applicants' academic records, standardized test scores, entrance examination and an interview score in Engineering, aptitude test and medical aviation exam.

1. Applicant qualifications

The applicant must satisfy one of the following requirements:

- a) Graduated Matthayom 6.
- b) Graduated a 12-Year or 13-Year education in an international school in Thailand or in a high school/secondary school abroad.
- c) Graduated or studying in the final year of a vocational program in a college in Thailand or abroad with a qualification equivalent to Matthayom 6 or higher and in which the main language of instruction is English.
- d) Obtained (or expect to obtain before the start of Academic Year 2016) a qualification equivalent to Matthayom 6 as approved by the Ministry of Education of Thailand.

3. Application submission

Apply on-line at www.reg.kmitl.ac.th and print out the application fee payment form and go to one of the banks, Kasikorn bank or Siam Commercial Bank, throughout the country to make the payment. The application fee is 500 THB and the service charge is 10 THB separately. The University accepts no obligation to refund any fee, or part thereof.

4. Announcement of the qualified shortlist and accepted applicants

The list of qualified shortlist and accepted applicants will be announced on http://aviation.kmitl.ac.th.

5. Number of acceptances

Aeronautical Engineering and Commercial Pilot program expects to accept 30 students from this round of direct admission. Aeronautical Engineering and Commercial Pilot program may accept a lower or greater number of students depending on the number of qualified applicants.

6. Tuition fee

The tuition fees for student entering the program in Academic Year 2016 are separated in to 2 parts per semester. The first is the tuition fee for commercial pilot course which is 350,000 THB. (Paid directly to Asia Aviation Academy, AAA) The second is the tuition fee for aeronautical engineering course which is 90,000 THB (Paid to KMITL informed in www.reg.kmitl.ac.th) on specified date.
